SUBJECT: Victorian COVID-19 Restrictions Update

ATTENTION: Chief Executive Officer

Victoria will enter a five-day snap lockdown from midnight tonight.

Premier Daniel Andrews announced the lockdown in light of an increase in locally acquired Covid-19 cases in Victoria in the past 24 hours.

Accordingly, state wide from 11:59pm Thursday 15 July until 11.59pm next Tuesday 20 July:

- Restrictions will be identical to Victoria's most recent circuit breaker lockdown. The same groups of workers will be authorised to work, and the same businesses will be allowed to open.
- There will be five permitted reasons to leave home.
- The five kilometre from home radius will be reinstated.

The Premier said that regional areas will be released earlier if it is safe to do so, and that the lockdown measures were aimed to be 'as simple as possible' but 'proportionate'.

We will provide additional information as it becomes available, including recently announced covid disaster payment measures.
